second part. Witnesses that the said party of the first part
for and in Consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars which
we had paid by the said party of the second part in good and
lawful money of the United States of America the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged and Confessed both bargained and
enjoyed conveyed and Confirmed and by these presents doth
bargain sell enfeoff Convey and Confirm unto the said party
of the second part his heirs and assigns forever in fee
simple the following described lands situate lying and being
in the County of Santa Rosa aforesaid. Known and distinguished
to wit: Also the East half of the East half of Section No. Four
teen in Township No. Two of Range No. Twelve seven N. & W.
in the districts of lands subject to sale at Land Office of the
United States aforesaid in the City of Tallahassee and State of
Florida Containing one hundred and fifty nine acres
and Ninety hundredths of an acre Together with all and
singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto
belonging or in any wise appertaining and the revenues
& Rents & profits thereof and also all the estate right title in-
terest claim or demand whatsoever of the said party
of the first part either in law or equity of in and to the
above bargained premises with the said hereditaments
and appurtenances To have and to hold the said
bargained and described premises as above particularly
mentioned and described to the said party of the second
part his heirs and assigns forever And the said
party of the first part for himself his heirs executors
and administrators doth hereby covenant to warrant
and defend the said party of the second part in the
title and quiet enjoyment of the premises hereby
