 Count of Cheshire the first day of January in the year of
 our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty before
 me the subscriber a Justice of the Peace for said County duly
 commissioned and qualified and authorized by the laws
 of said State to take the acknowledgment of Deeds &c personally
 appeared Timothy Twitchell and Susan Twitchell his wife to
 me known to be the persons who executed the foregoing deed
 by them sealed & subscribed and they severally acknowledged
 the execution thereof to be their free act and deed for the uses
 and purposes therein mentioned and the said Susan Twitchell
 wife of said Timothy Twitchell being privately examined by
 me separate and apart from her husband whether the within
 relinquishment of Power and other rights was made freely
 and voluntarily and without any constraint compulsion
 apprehension or fear of or from her said husband
 answers and says that she did and does acknowledge the
 same to have been freely and voluntarily made and without
 any constraint compulsion apprehension or fear of or from
 her said husband Witness my hand and seal this
 Twenty first day of January A.D. 1860
