 relinquished unto the said W W Tate his heirs and assigns
 all my right and title of in and to any and all Power to
 Lot (No. 16) six in Block no. (23) twenty three fronting on Ocean
 beach about one hundred feet by one hundred feet in depth
 lying and being in the town of Milton County and State aforesaid.
 The same Lot or parcel of land was conveyed by my
 said husband to W W Tate the 13th day of March A.D. 1858 and
 since then by W W Tate to Samuel Rushing. Witness my
