 the said D. C. Mourse his heirs and assigns the
 property above mentioned. Yet upon this con-
 dition that if I the said Enosh Dyak shall pay
 or cause to be paid unto the said D. C. Mourse
 his heirs and assigns the amount due to said Mourse
 for the said supplies then this Bill of Sale to be void and of no effect
 otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
