 distinguished as the north West half of Lot number (6) six  
 in Block number (23) twenty three in the plan of said town  
 and fronting on Escambia Street fifty (50) feet by one hun-

 wise appertaining and the reversion and reversions remainders  
 and remainders unto issues and profits thereof and also  
 all the estate right title interest claim or demand whatsoever
