County of Santa Rosa } Forchheimer and J. G. ducheimier & Co. and against
Anglar Patchelder & Poley, J. John W. Butler Sheriff in and for said County
did levy upon and advertise according to law the following described
real estate and sell the same before the Court House door in the
town of Melton on the 1st Monday in December A.D. 1870 to the
highest and best bidder for cash to wit: Lot Number
One in Section Number Twenty three Township number one
North of Range being right West in the state and County
aforesaid and to-wit: George Haskell was the highest and
best bidder for said lands at and for the sum of thirty
five dollars. Now know all men by these presents that
John W. Butler Sheriff as aforesaid in accordance with
the premises and for and in consideration of the said sum
have bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do
bargain sell and convey unto the said George Haskell all
the right title interest and claim of Anglar Patchelder & Poley
of in and to the above described lands together with the im-
provements and appurtenances thereto belonging.
