 Know all men by these presents that we F. Wilkins  
 and Robert Sheppard partners trading and doing  
 business under the name and style of Wilkins & Sheppard being desirous  
 of entering into and carrying on the business of getting saw logs and  
 said County, and whereas Joseph Olinger Merchant of the town of  
 Milton in said County, a State agent to furnish us the said Wilkins  
 & Sheppard from time to time with the necessary provisions and supplies  
 for carrying on said business and on the said Wilkins & Sheppard  
 being desirous of securing the said Olinger in the payment  
 of the said advances or moneys to be duly credit and made unto  
 the said Joseph Olinger, his heirs and assigns a lien on all the  
 logs so got by us under and by virtue of an act of the Legislature  
 of the State of Florida, entitled an Act to enable and grant  
 persons to obtain credit and to secure the lender, approved  
 February 16<sup>th</sup> 1870 and the further to secure the said Olinger  
 in the payment for said advances we the said Wilkins &  
 Sheppard do hereby bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Olinger  
 his heirs and assigns and of the heirs of Olinger, his assigns and  
 assigns our interest with time and not time in the left for  
 and we make in the right, to be paid for the same while Olinger  
 man and with time and over it in the right ear and split  
 and under it in the left ear, David C. G. to have and to hold  
 to the said Olinger and his heirs and assigns unto the said Joseph Olinger his  
 heirs and assigns forever. Yet upon the condition of the  
 said Olinger shall be punctually paid for his advances  
 so made by him from time to time but this bill of sale
