of the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the

Allum, hath and beareth unto the said party of the second part
hath given granted, aliened, released and confirmed, and by these
presents doth give grant alien in full and confirm unto the
said party of the second part, in the manner and may as aforesaid
mentioned and intended, their heirs and assigns to be and remain
their separate and independent property, all that messuage or
lot of land, situate lying and being in the Corporate limits of
the town of Milton, aforesaid known and distinguished as a
lot of lots with William J. Heyson, Alexander M. Day and
Joseph H. Bone laid out off and plattd by Surveyor James
