Copy of deed of conveyance from Tom Hunt to Santa Rosa County

Copy near as is known, of a deed of conveyance from Tom Hunt to the county of Santa Rosa, State of Florida, the Original of which together with the Record, thereof were destroyed by the fire which occurred on the night of the 13th July A.D. 1869 in the town of Moulton and County and State aforesaid, to wit:

This deed of conveyance, made and entered into, this (that is to say some month & some day of the month in the early part) in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and sixty Six (between Tom Hunt of the County of Santa Rosa and State of Florida, of the first part, and the County of Santa Rosa in the State of Florida, of the second part - Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty Dollars, (or some other sum) of good and lawful money of the United States of America to him in hand paid, by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and conferred, has bargained, granted, sold, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents does bargain, grant, sell,
