 Memorandum of an agreement  
 made and entered into on this 11<sup>th</sup> day  
 of December A. D. 1875. by and between Henry Gray and  
 Elliott Presley both of the State and County aforesaid. Witness  
 that whereas the said Elliott Presley has been assisting the  
 said Gray to carry the U. S. Mail from Milton to  
 Henry [unclear] by furnishing such and other articles for so  
 doing and whereas the said Presley has this day furnished  
 to said Gray for the purpose aforesaid, a certain gray horse  
 bought by said Presley from William E. McHale and the  
 said Presley, by this, furnishing said horse hereby relinquish-  
 all his claims to the same, unto the said Gray. even known  
 alimony by these presents, that I the said Henry Gray  
 for the consideration aforesaid and for the further  
 consideration of the sum of one dollar to me in hand  
 paid by the said Presley (the receipt whereof is hereby  
 acknowledged) have given and granted and by these  
 presents do give grant and deliver unto the said Presley  
 his heirs and assigns all the pay or emoluments which  
 are now due or may become due to me for carrying  
 said mail from this date until the time for which my  
 contract expires, which will be on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of  
 June A. D. 1876. And I further agree that in case I  
 should for any cause fail to carry said mail until the  
 expiration of my said contract on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of June next  
 then the said Gray here shall revert to the said Elliott  
 Presley his heirs and assigns. And I the said Gray do  
 hereby authorize the said Presley his heirs or assigns to sign  
 the necessary receipts in order to enable them to obtain  
 the pay that may become due to me. In testimony whereof  
 I the said Henry Gray have hereunto set my hand and seal
