Know all men by these presents that whereas the Circuit Court of the First Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida in a case wherein Chas B. Black and Chas E. Black Defendants under the firm name of Chas Black and Sons were Plaintiff and

George F. C. Baleschewer and John C. Poley surviving partners of the firm of Poley, Oriskany & Co. Baleschewer, Ceyler Poley and Thomas Murray & Co. Richard E. Campbell were Defendants. Do on the 11th day of August A.D. 1875 bear a decree foreclosing the said defendants and all persons claiming under them of any kind or under them of any form all right and equity of redemption in and to the following described parcel of land being and lying in Santa Rosa County, State of Florida - viz Lots (1) one and (5) five in Section (10) New Township (1) one Range (28) Twenty Eight - on the west bank of Blackwater and containing 142 ²⁰/₁₀₀ One hundred and forty two ²⁰/₁₀₀ acres.

And by said decree it was ordered that the above property be sold by Henry T. Wright Trustee previous by (viz December 28th 1868 appointed by said court; Now therefore by virtue of the authority in me vested of Henry T. Wright Trustee as aforesaid viz on the 8th day of April A.D. 1876 having given notice of the time and place of sale as required by law, after first at public outcry during the usual hours of sale at the appointed place in the town of Milton - the above described real Estate and Personal Davison having made the best and highest bid therefore viz: fifteen ⁶⁴/₁₀₀ (\$15 ⁶⁴/₁₀₀ became the purchase thereof.

Now therefore in pursuance of the said decree and by virtue of the authority in me thereby vested - I Henry T. Wright Trustee for and in consideration of the premises as well as the said sum of fifteen ⁶⁴/₁₀₀ Dollars to me in hand paid, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Geoman Davison all the right title and interest of the said Defendants in and to the foregoing described parcel or parcels of land to have and to hold unto the said Geoman Davison his heirs and assigns forever.
