

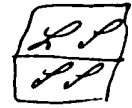

Alfred Holley and Tempy Holley his wife, for
and in consideration of the sum of five Dollars, to us in hand paid
by Alfred Holley the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have
given, granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do
bargain, sell and deliver, unto the said Alfred S. Holley
his heirs and assigns the following described lot or parcel
of land lying and being situated in the Town of Milton in
the State of Florida, to wit: All of Lot No. 4 in Block
one (in Duvaltown) Except one fourth acre in the S. E. corner,
of said Lot: being 3/4 of an acre upon which is situated three
dwelling houses and one store house, also Lot Number two
in Block situated fronting on Willing Street, to wit: commencing
at the corner bounding said Lot, and Lot Number four, in said
Block, on said Willing Street running thence on a line bounding
said Lots back from said Street 71 yards & 4 inches thence on a
parallel line with said Street, and thence said Lot of 2, 18 yards
1 foot 10 1/2 inches, thence at right angles, and parallel with
said bounding line 21 yards & 4 inches to said Street, and thence
on a margin of said Street, 18 yards 1 foot 10 1/2 inches to the
place of beginning. together with all and singular the appurtenances
and improvements thereto belonging, to have and to hold
the same unto the said Alfred S. Holley his heirs and assigns
forever; And we the said Alfred Holley and Tempy Holley
his wife for ourselves, our heirs executors and administrators
do hereby covenant, to warrant and defend the said, Alfred
S. Holley his wife and assigns in the title and quiet
enjoyment; of the premises hereby conveyed, In testimony
