To all whom it may concern
 Whereas W. L. Wittich has this day loaned
 to us Messrs. Mallou & Davis Partners by the name and
 style of Mallou & Davis, the sum of twelve thousand dollars, and
 also in addition thereto agreed to advance the further sum of
 fifteen hundred dollars, in months for the period of one year
 from the date hereof to aid us in the business of lumber getting
 in the manufacture of ^{Board} lumber of lumber, at two miles
 in Santa Rosa County, State of Georgia, now therefore we in
 consideration, thereof hereby give to the said W. L. Wittich a
 Power (a give full consent thereto) on all the timber
 lumber and logs, that may be obtained & manufactured by
 us in and during the period of one year & until the claims
 of said W. L. Wittich upon us in virtue of this contract
 are fully satisfied & released, We also consent, that the
 said shall enclose two thousand five hundred logs now
 on hand, and all sawn timber & lumber now in our
 possession, We further agree and consent that the fifteen
 hundred dollars, per month above stated may be advanced
 by furnishing supplies to us of merchandise and that for
 said monthly advances the said W. L. Wittich shall have
 & receive the further sum of two & half per cent for advancing
 and as a commission additional thereto & also the further
 sum of one per cent upon any & all amounts left over as
 unpaid balances of the said fifteen hundred dollars at the
 end of each and every month all of which said several
 amounts we agree & consent shall be paid to the conditions
 of this then We also further agree consent & engage that
 all timber hereafter cut by us, shall as readily as
 possible be shipped by us & sent to Ferry Gap, in
 said County & that it shall there be impounded in the name
 of the said W. L. Wittich & paid on his account the said
 W. L. Wittich having the privilege & option of selling the
 said timber & lumber at taking it at the market price &
 placing the proceeds thereof to the credit of said Mallou
 & Davis, We also further agree & consent that if from any
 cause we are prevented or fail to carry on our said business
 & to run our mill the said W. L. Wittich is hereby
 empowered & authorized to take full & complete possession
 of the same & to carry on our said business on our account
 crediting us with the net proceeds until he is fully repaid for
 the above loan with interest and the agreed commission &
 interest on all advances made by him. To all of which
 we hereby fully consent & agree in consideration of the
 loan of money & advances made to us by the said W. L.
 Wittich as above stated & set forth. In witness whereof
