Santa Rosa County, known all men by these presents, that whereas the Circuit Court, of the first Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, in a case wherein Chas Black & Chas. B. Black Copartners with the firm name of Chas Black & Son were Plaintiffs and Geo. L. Bigler, George E. Batchelor & John B. Poole removing partners of the firm of Poole, Batchelor & Co., Batchelor, Bigler & Co., Batchelor, Bigler and Poole and Thomas Murray & Co. and Richard L. Campbell were Defendants.

Did on the 11th day of August 1875 render a decree foreclosing the said defendants and all persons claiming in or to claim, by through or under them, of and from all right and Equity of redemption in and to the following piece or parcel of Land, viz: Lot no. 1 in block East Quarter of Section (23) twenty three in Township (1) one Range (28) twenty eight - containing (132) one hundred & thirty two acres and being on the west side of Blackwater Bay, in St. Rosa County, State of Florida - and by said decree it was ordered that the said property be sold by Henry F. Wright, Trustee previously appointed by said Court.

By virtue of the authority in me vested by a decree issued from said Court, on December 29th A.D. 1868. As well as the decree above set forth of Henry F. Wright Trustee as aforesaid did on the 3rd day of April A.D. 1876. Having given notice of the time and place of sale as required by Law - offer for sale, at Public outcry during the usual hours of sale, at the appointed place in the town of Milton Florida the above described lot of Land and George Barklee having made the best and highest bid viz (11. ²²/₁₀₀ Eleven Dollars and twenty two cents for the above described (132) one hundred and thirty two acres, the said Barklee became the purchaser thereof.
