W. Amos the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargain  
sold conveyed and transferred, and by these presents do bargain  
sell convey and deliver unto the said N. A. Amos his heirs  
and assigns the following described lands parcels of land lying and  
being in the town of Milton State of Georgia, to wit: So much of the Southern portion  
of Lot number Five in Block number Twenty as fronts  
Twenty Eight feet and six inches on Milling Street by sixty  
feet in depth on which said Lot number Five is situated the  
Store house now occupied by said Amos & Minto also the  
southern half of said Store house which southern half is  
situated upon the above described portion of said Lot number  
Five the dividing line of said store house to run directly and  
immediately through the center of the building from East  
to West, and from the foundation to the roof inclusive also  
so much of the Southern portion of Lot Eight of record  
to a place made by Mr F. Lee subdividing a lot on Block  
Twenty which Block formerly belonged to the Estate of James  
C. Sempron deceased, as fronts Twenty Eight feet and six  
inches upon the Eastern boundary of that portion of Lot Five  
in Block Twenty heretofore described and running back  
Twenty five feet, together with all the appurtenances and
