the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hath given granted
and by these presents, hath given granted bargain sold convey and
confer unto the party of the second part, all the interest
which the party of the first part holds, that is to say an
undivided five eighths (5/8) interest in & to certain Lands
& town lots in the County of Escomb and Santa Rosa, in
the State of Florida the same being the lands particularly
described in a deed of conveyance from Taylor Stone by his
Attorney C. A. Perry to the said B. C. Cobb, dated 29th
day of August 1875 and recorded in the County of Escomb
& Santa Rosa, to which I do refer in hereby made, for
description & boundaries. To have & to hold the said lands
in the lands aforesaid unto the said party of the 2^d part
his heirs and assigns forever, free from any rule claim
and part of the party of the first part, or any claiming by
