Adenito James <sup>of my plantation</sup> and from James James to Allen Blalock and from Allen Blalock to me (per deed of Gift) said lands are bounded on the north by lands belongg to William Miller on the east by Baillias Boyau on the South by St Mary del Goloos Bay and on the West by lands belonging to William Miller and John Brown and also one Shiff Boat to have and to hold unto her the said Jane E. Blalock and her heirs forever, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 6<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1875.
