Know all men by these presents, that I, Henry Lewis of
said State and County for and in consideration of one Dollar to me in
hand paid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) by Joseph
Ollinger of the same State and County, and in consideration of other
matters hereinafter mentioned, I have given granted bargained and sold
and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto the said Joseph
Ollinger his executors administrators assigns, the following described
personally property to wit: One flock of Olden known and described as
follows - viz. both of said Olden being of a black color and named respectively
"Lip" & "Cooley". Also one Wagon, the same being an Iron Horse -
all of said property being now owned by me and in my possession in
the County of Santa Rosa, State of Florida - To have and to hold said
described property unto the said Joseph Ollinger his executors, administrators
and assigns to him and their uses and behoof forever -
And the above instrument is intended as a mortgage, the provisions of
which are these: to wit: That whereas the said Henry Lewis is
indebted to the said Ollinger in the sum of Fifty eight & $\frac{11}{100}$ (\$58.11)
Dollars for goods wares and merchandise, and whereas the said Ollinger & Lewis
have agreed that the said Ollinger shall furnish to said Lewis goods wares & merchandise to the amount
of Fifty (\$50) Dollars, in addition to said amount already mentioned as furnished from time to
time as said Lewis shall require same within the term of this mortgage. Now then that if said
Lewis shall sell and truly pay said amounts mentioned for said merchandise to said Ollinger within
Twelve months from the date of this instrument, then this obligation to be null and void, else
to be of full force and virtue, and in the event of a fore closure of this mortgage, said Lewis to pay to
said Ollinger his costs and reasonable attorney's fee, the same to be included in and
covered by this mortgage - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal,
