We, L. B. Wombwell and F. B. Bonifay

being duly sworn depose and say. We were the Agents appointed respectively by Governor W. D. Bloxham and Governor E. A. Perry, to select the lands within the fifteen mile limit claimed by the Pensacola and Atlantic Railroad Company as owing to it, as a part of the line of Railroad from the Saint John's River at Jacksonville to the mouth of Escambia Bay at or near Pensacola Florida by virtue of the Act of Congress approved May 17, 1856, entitled "An Act granting Public Lands to the States of Florida and Alabama, to aid in the Construction of Certain Railroads in said States." And the Act of the Legislature of the State of Florida, approved March 4, 1851, entitled "An act to incorporate the Pensacola and Atlantic Railroad Company and to grant Certain lands to the same," as indemnity for Lands which had been previously sold or granted within the six mile limit to the United States. We have carefully examined the list of land books attached, which were granted to the State of Florida and approved by the Hon. J. Thompson, Secretary of the Interior on the 29th day of October 1860, as per the Certificate of the Hon. Wm. A. J. Sparks, Commissioner of the General Land Office, books attached, dated October 4, 1857, and we have carefully compared said List with the list of Lands selected by us, and find that we had not selected all the Lands embraced in said list attached but only a portion thereof. Such lands as were selected by L. B. Wombwell are designated on the margin of said List thus "W." and such as were selected by F. B. Bonifay are designated thus "B." and such as were not selected by either and designated thus "—".
