 Township two (2) of Range Two (2) and NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of section one (1) in Township three (3) of Range Two (2) and NW 1/4 of
 (29) NW and E 1/4 of section Twelve (12) in Township three (3)
 Range Two (2) NW all of the above described
 Grants lying in Santa Rosa County, State of Florida.
