 is meant all land lying between said blocks ten
 (10) seven (7) and lots five (5) and six (6) in Block thirteen
 (13) and the river known as Blackwater River (the said
 lots and parcels being properly represented by a plat
 recorded April 22-1873 in Deed Book B. on page
 six hundred and sixty six (666) in Records of Santa Rosa
 County, State of Florida,) also the following described
 property to wit: all the land on the river front for the
 distance of forty (40) feet back from high water mark
 belonging to and contained in the unsurveyed tract
 of land in section two (2) and three (3) Township
 one (1) N Range twenty eight (28) W described and
 known on the official plat as the Melton Ferry, less
 such land as may have been heretofore sold to Wm
 Redd: Also excepting four hundred and fifty (450) feet back
 and fifty (50) feet south of the lumber beds now standing
 and owned by or known as the property of Mayer Brothers
 in the said Town of Milton. Also the following described
 land in Santa Rosa County - State of Florida to wit: 1/2 of 1/4
 and the S 1/4 of section (6) six (6) Township four (4) Range twenty
 nine (29) N and W, also the following described land in the
 Town of Milton said County and State - to wit: Lots 12 from (12)
 six (6) and eight (8) in Block 12 seven (7) each lot having
 length of one hundred (100) feet ^{north} and south and one hundred

 official plat as the Melton Ferry Excepting four hundred (400)
 feet north ^{(the said (3) feet)} and south of the lumber beds now standing, and
 own by or known as the property of Mayer Brothers and
 property herein conveyed having a water front of 150 feet
 (150) feet. Also a parcel or tract of land on the
 East side of Blackwater River just below the Melton Ferry
 on said E side of said River (the said parcel being a
 part of what is known as the Ferry lot of 1/2 and
 formerly owned by Wm. Harrison and sold
