to

This Indenture made the 1st day of Sept 1891
between R. C. Sheppard of the Town of Milton
Santa Rosa County Florida of the first part and
H. J. Williams of the same place of the second
part Witnesseth that whereas the party of the first
part is jointly indebted to sundry persons in divers and
several sums of money, and being unable to pay the
same in full as they are or may become due, and
is desirous of providing for the payment thereof by an
assignment of his property and effects for that purpose
in pursuance of Chapter (3891) Laws of Florida 1889;
Now therefore the party of the first part for and in
consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid
by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged and confessed and in
consideration of the premises, has given, granted
bargained sold conveyed assigned & demanded and
by these presents do give, grant, bargain sell convey
assign & deliver unto said party of the second part
