Whereas there has been deposited in the general Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Gainesville Florida, which it appears that pursuant to the act of Congress approved 20th May 1862 "to remove Hornsteads to actual Settlers on the Public Domain" and the acts supplemental thereto the claim of Doris Sewell has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law for the East half of the South East quarter of section thirty two in Township four North of Range twenty nine West of Tallahassee Meridian in Florida, containing seventy nine acres and nearly eight hundredths, according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.

Now Know ye that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Doris Sewell the tract of Land above described: To Have and to hold the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereof unto the said Doris Sewell and to his heirs and assigns forever In testimony whereof Benjamin Harrison President of the United States of America has caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
