Know all men by these presents
 that I, Stephen Carr, of Santa Rosa County, State of Florida
 for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar to me in hand
 paid by John S. Barrett of said County & State of Florida
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged & confessed, have given
 granted, bargained & sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell,
 & convey unto the said John S. Barrett & his assigns certain property,
 to-wit: as described as follows, to-wit: one yoke of Oxen - one of them a
 blackish brown color & one a yellow color - the same having been purchased
 of George Brown. And one yoke of Oxen - one of them a brown color purchased
 of Dan Carr & one a yellow color - purchased of Jesse Davis, also one Iron
 axle log cut - 6 feet 8 inches high & 4 inches on the tread, also all the old
 logs now in Shoal River & Yellow River branded with a blaze & two chops in
 it - three (3) on one side of the log & a blaze & one chop - three (3) on
 opposite side of the log. Estimated to be 400 of these logs - more or less.
 Also what new logs are now in said rivers branded three (3) a blaze
 and two chops on one side of the log & three (3) a blaze & one chop on the
 blaze on opposite side of the log. Estimated to be 200 of these logs.
 To have & to hold the above described property to the said John S. Barrett his
 heirs & assigns, subject to the following conditions, That whereas the said
 Stephen C. Carr is at the date hereof justly indebted to the said John S. Barrett
 in the sum of Two hundred & eighty two & 2/3 dollars (\$282.22) & the said
 Barrett agrees to advance the said Carr the sum of Fifty (50)
 in cash with which to buy land & Thirty (30) dollars on account of the new
 saw logs now in the water in the said rivers, & to advance to the
 said Carr the sum of Fifty (50) dollars in Merchandise, per month,
 for the next six (6) months from & after the date hereof to enable him
 the said Carr to carry on the business of getting & delivering
 Pitch Pine saw logs of good merchantable quality & the said
 logs to be the property of the said Barrett from the time they are
