Agreement  
 of J. Houghs  
 to  
 Parodi & Co

This agreement made and entered into this 10<sup>th</sup>  
 day of November 1891, by and between J. Houghs of  
 Madison County Florida and Parodi & Co of Bay Point  
 Santa Rosa County Florida. Witnesseth.

That whereas said J. Houghs now has in Spaul  
 River Florida and in its tributaries three thousand  
 (3000) or more, pitch pine Saw Logs which he  
 hereby agrees to sell to said Parodi & Co at the  
 following prices viz: for logs measuring four to ten  
 (4) cubic feet up to (17) ft (5 1/2) five cents per cubic  
 foot; and for logs measuring (17) to seven to ten cubic  
 feet & up words (5 1/2) five and a half cents per cubic  
 foot - And said Parodi & Co hereby agree to  
 buy & pay for said logs, said prices above mentioned  
 & being understood that said J. Houghs  
 shall drive or have said logs driven to the  
 Boom at the mouth of Yellow River as soon  
 as water will admit, and deliver them for  
 inspection to such inspector as said Parodi & Co  
 shall select - Said logs however not to be  
 deemed delivered until the same shall have  
 been inspected & delivered to said Parodi & Co or  
 their agents to receive them.

Now it is further more agreed and understood  
 that all logs, inspection of length or cubic measure-  
 ments, not measuring eleven (11) inch in diameter  
 shall not be deemed bargained or sold at  
 the prices above mentioned, but shall be set  
 apart, the price to be paid for them subject to such  
 agreement as said Houghs & said Parodi & Co then
