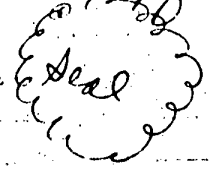

Know all men by these presents that the Board of Education of Florida, under an act of the Legislature of the State of Florida entitled "An Act to establish a uniform system of common schools and a university" approved January 30, 1869 and the present Constitution of said State, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar & twenty five cents per acre, to them in hand paid by Elijah Jernigan of the County of Santa Rosa State of Florida have granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Elijah Jernigan and his heirs and assigns forever the following described lands to-wit: The north east quarter of the south west quarter of section sixteen (16) in Township five (5) North of Range Twenty Seven (27) West, containing thirty nine & 9/10 acres and lying and being in the County of Santa Rosa in said State of Florida, To have and to hold the said lands unto the said Elijah Jernigan and his heirs and assigns forever, In testimony whereof the members of said Board have hereunto subscribed their names and affixed their seals and have caused the seal of the Department of Agriculture of the State of Florida to be hereunto affixed at the Capital in the City of Tallahassee, on this the Twenty first day of October AD Eighteen hundred and ninety one
