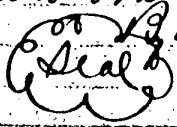

Homestead Certificate No 3948. Application 1859. Ohyll Come, Granting
Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Gainesville Florida whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May 1862 "To Secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the public Domain" and in accordance with supplemental thereto, the claim of Thomas W. Penton has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the South East Quarter of Section twenty four in Township four North of Range thirty west of Tallahassee Meridian in Florida containing one hundred and six acres and fifty six hundredth part according to the official plat of survey of the land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General

Now Know Ye that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Thomas W. Penton the tract of land above described to have and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances thereof unto the said Thomas W. Penton and to his heirs and assigns forever

In testimony whereof Benjamin Harrison President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City of Washington the nineteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety one - and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and fiftieth
