State County as assignor of A. R. Shippard by
virtue of assignment deed dated Sept 1st 1891

in consideration of one hundred & seventy seven
dollars to me in hand paid by C. C. M^{rs} Dougall of
said State County; the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged and confirmed, have given granted
bargained sold & assigned & by these presents do
give grant bargain sell & assign unto said
C. C. M^{rs} Dougall his heirs & assigns the following premises
to wit: My interest right and title in & to the franchise
of which is known as the "Millon Ferry" said Ferry being
located at Millon Santa Rosa County Florida and
known as the "Millon Ferry" together with the
Flat Boat Chain, rope & rigging belonging to
same & known as the Ferry Flat of said Ferry;
also (2) Skiff boats used in connection therewith
& pertaining to said Ferry; also the right of
ingress & egress to said Ferry over such lands
as were originally owned by Richard Amos in
the vicinity of said Ferry; also all such rights
& privileges in & to the land the Plank Walk extend-
ing from said Ferry on the East side to which is
known as the Marquis place for the accommodation
of boats crossing the said Ferry, as was granted
