I David Howard of Annarundell in the Province of Maryland Carpent<sup>r</sup> being at the this time in good and perfect memory through the Mercy of God do make this my Last will and testament in manner following that is to say

I do Give unto my brother John Frizell one Cask of Nails Containing Five thousand single tens and one thousand double tenns and what more nails is therein Contained and I also bequeath to the said John one box of Goods Containing one p<sup>ce</sup> of Bleu Linnen Three pair of Worsted Stockings and three of yarn and Six Pair mens shoes

I do Give unto My Sister Eliz<sup>a</sup> Frizell one Warming Pann and one Gold Ring and one moiety of all the Pewter belonging to me

I do give to my said Sisters daughter Priscilla Frizell one wrought Gold Ring

I Give to my Sisters son John Frizell my fowling Piece

I do give and bequeath to my Sister mary Davis my Rideing Horse and one Gold ring and one moiety of my Pewter.

I do Give and bequeath to my Brother Robert Howard all the plantation he now liveth upon with all the Buildings thereunto belonging

I do Give and bequeath unto my Brother Charles Howard and James Howard after my Just debts and funeral Charges is paid to be Equally devided between them all my wearing Apparell and all my working Tools with all my debts and whatsoever Else shall be found belonging to me

Lastly I do make and Constitute my brother Charles Howard Executor of this my Last will and testament

Written with my own hand this second day of Oct<sup>r</sup> in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand Seven hundred and Three
