Highlights of this Cemetary:

Grave of Francis Marcus Berdanier, who joined Napoleon Bonaparte's Army in 1810.

Three War of 1812 Veterans.

One Mexican War Veteran.

Over Forty Civil War Veterans.

The Lutheran church records are maintained at the Lutheran Church on the corner of Coal and Cherry Streets in Port Carbon. The original church building was located where the cemetary fronts on Coal Street.
