KRETCHMANS CEMETERY 1142

Situated on the old Ellis Kretchman Farm in Elk Lick Township, Somerset County, Pa. in the field above the barn north side of a ravine about 30 rods from the building destroyed and now farmed over. Said to contain the bodies of Henry Kretchman who died the first part of 1831, his wife and possibly several children. Mrs. Kretchman's maiden name was snyder.

Said to contain the bodies of Philip and Harry Handwerk and their mother, Mollie and possibly Peter Handwerk. Peter Handwerk died in 1839, and Philip Handwerk died in 1854.

AMISH MENNONITE CHURCH CEMETERY ELØ

SITUATED in Elk Lick Twp. Somerset Co. Pa, near Amish ennonite Church, 1/4 mile west of Niverton; 1 miles mast of Springs.

THE Cemetery of the Amish Mennonite Mensuites at Niverton, in Elk Lick Twp. was started about 1882. Prior to this date this denomination hadno regular houses of worship, but held their meetings in the dwelling houses of the members, Funeral services were also held in dwelling houses, therfore there were scattered local grave pards started in many sections.

In 1881 this church built 4 church houses (generally called meeting houses) One at Niverton, one near Summit Mills and two in Garrett Co. Md.

Cemeteries were soon started at all of these churches, where practically all of their interments are now made.

One grave not marked (Peter Beachy is buried here. Died about 1869. Was over 90 years old. This information comes from persons who remember him. This was the second Peter Beachy - husband of BARBARA BEACHY, previously noted.

There were the parents of Bishop Joel Beachy and Aaron Beachy, both very prominent and highly respected citizens

of Garret Co. Md.

Peter Beachys father was also named Peter and was the first Beachy to settle in Somerset County. He was buried in the grave yard on the Amos Yoder farm near Springs Somerset Co. Pa. SITUATED IN ELKLICK TWP. SOMERSET CO. PA. ON THE FARM OWNED BY L. L. BEACHY, ON THE TOP OF THE HILL WEST OF THE BUILDINGS AND NORTH OF THE OLD ROAD LEADING FROM WEST SALISBURY TO SPRINGS.

Known as "Old Cemetery", situated on a hill at the eastern end of Salisbury, Elk Lick Twp. Somerset Co. Pa.

Local History:

This old burial place usually referred to, by the town people, as "The Old Cemetery on the Hill" to distinguish it from the newer, Odd Fellows Cemetery of Salisbury, is undoubtedly the tonw's first burial ground. There seem to be no records available to tell us just when the cemetery was started, but the oldest inscribed date of death found therein is 1815. It was in this same year that Peter Shirer, one of the town's founders, built the first store in Salisbury but as the beginning of the town dates back to 1796, it is probable that some of the many uniscribed graves are older than 1815.

To get an accurate record of the number of graves here as practically impossible because of the haphazard unsystematic way in which the older graves, with field stone markers, are arranged. In many cases a headstone or a foot stone seems to be lacking, and the graves are so spaced that one is likely to mistake the headstone of a child's grave for the foot stone of an adult one, or vice versa. Also, there is no way of determining shether the various loose stones, lying about here and ther (some inscribed) or leaning against trees, belong to graves yet in the cemetery but no longer evident to the eye, or belong to some of the former graves from which bodies were removed and transferred to the town's newer cemetery. However, it is safe to estimate that there are at least 270 persons buried here, most of them people who died before 1880. There are comparitively few graves after that date, though there are several since 1900, and one in 1933

Two interesting points might be noted in connection with this cemetery. The one is the fact that two or three veterans (the one German born) of the Nevolutionary War are found buried here. The other point is the occurrence of a rather striking phenomenon. When the body of one Henry Brewer, an old man, was take up and removed to another cemetery some years ago, it was found to be completely petrified, and recognizable to former acquaintances. This hardening process had not apparently affected the other bodies that were move from the cemetery.
